**Board of Supervisors strategic planning session start time rescheduled**

NAPA – The Napa County Board of Supervisors will begin its next strategic planning session at 9:30 a.m., Monday, April 24, in the Napa Valley College Community Room, 2277 Napa Vallejo Hwy, Room #1731.

The planning session follows five community vision meetings where dozens of residents throughout the county attended to share their views about priorities for Napa County. Feedback was also collected through an online survey.

Monday’s meeting, which is open to the public, is the second of three scheduled strategic planning sessions. The board is expected to discuss priorities, strategies and outcomes to achieve the vision.
